This will benefit all students. They will be able to have notes available before class begins. Students will be able to follow along with the notes in class with ease. This will put them in sync with the smart board and make it so they don't need to bring a notebook to class. This will cut down on the amount of time taken in notes and increase the amount of instruction time available in class. There are three important things that students will need when looking for a tablet or a 2-in1 computer:

(1) They will need email access (also used for English class). Mr. Willson will be emailing the student notes for the class. Students in Physics will also be able to do their homework on the tablet and email the homework back to him.

(2) They will need access to PowerPoint or Google Slides in order to access the files he sends them. (Also used for English)

(3) They will need a digital pen. **NOT A STYLUS!** This will allow them to write on the slides and homework with accuracy. Examples of this are Samsung S Pen, Google Pixel book Pen, Apple Pencil, or the Lenovo Active Pen. I use the Lenovo in class currently.
